



Higher Pandemic Alert to Safeguard THU



CECC raised epidemic warning to Level 2 and implemented related restrictions and measures, effective from May 11 to June 8, in response to increased risk of community transmission

1. From now on, the campus is closed to the public. Visitors for business must have their National Health Insurance Cards or Resident Certificates checked and documented).
2. Access to Tunghai is restricted to Main Campus Frontage, 2nd Campus Entrance, Side Entrance to the north of ST Building, and motorbike entrance to the dorm.
3. Food delivery services are no longer permitted into campus.
4. Entry to restaurants requires National Health Insurance Cards or Resident Certificates (checked and documented). Diners should alternate seats with partition boards.
5. School continues to strengthen disinfection. The Office of General Affairs will conduct outdoor environmental disinfection this weekend. The Office of Student Labor disinfects the classroom daily. The Office of Academic Affairs Increase night disinfection.
6. For the graduation ceremony originally scheduled on June 5th, only the award representatives will be present and the ceremony will be in live streaming.
7. The Sunday Worship at the Luce Chapel will be in live streaming starting from this week.
8. From 5/14, the library will decline the entry of visitors (with guest passes). The study area in the basement will be closed, too.
9. Courses with more than 100 students should take turns attending class starting from May 13; students with an odd number in the last digit of their student I.D. should come in one week and the ones with an even number in the week following; those who do not come should do online learning at home concurrently. Classes under 100 students should conduct class as usual.
10. Indoor activities (over 100 people) and outdoor gatherings (over 500 people) should be canceled. Activities on a smaller scale than the above should practice social distancing, alternate seats, and wear masks.
